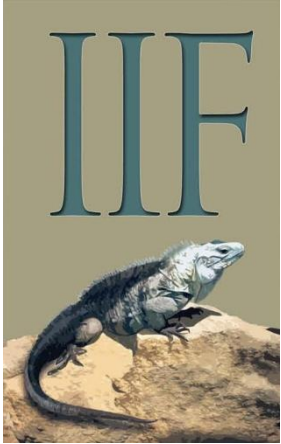


REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL



The International Iguana Foundation is pleased to announce their annual request for proposals for iguana conservation. A sample of a model application is also available to serve as a guide for applicants and to ensure consistency in format.

If you wish to submit, please note that all applications are **due by the end of business on, October 8, 2010.**

Final decisions will be made in early November 2010, at the annual Board of Directors meeting in Miami.

The International Iguana Foundation awards were established to promote and enable iguana conservation through partnerships with scientists, educators, and organizations committed to preserving earth's biodiversity.

Preference will be given to:

- Projects that are components of approved Species Recovery Plans
- Projects that are included in the ISG's Conservation Action Plan for West Indian Iguanas or are ISG endorsed
- Projects that directly contribute to the survival of endangered iguanas and their habitats
- Projects that are part of an established conservation program.

Criteria that the IIF will use to evaluate project proposals:

- The project has range country participation and has matching funds.
- The project builds on previous work contributing to an established commitment to a conservation program OR is well suited to become/contribute to a long-term conservation program.
- The project is grounded in sound scientific methodology, is logistically feasible, and has a high probability of success.
- The project has conservation value and a measurable impact.

Note:

- A project final report is required one year from receipt of funds and is mandatory for consideration of any future requests for funding. In addition, this year the IIF will require a condensed report, with photos, that is ready for posting on our website: www.iguanafoundation.org. This report should be "web palatable" and geared for public consumption, and not highly technical in nature.
- New applications will not be considered if these reports have not been received.

APPLICATION PROCESS AND STRUCTURE

Only applications that adhere to the following guidelines will be considered.

1. APPLICATION COVER SHEET

- Complete the cover sheet (type or print)
- Attach the cover sheet as page 1 of your proposal

2. **PROPOSAL OUTLINE** – the following information should be included under the sub-headings listed below. This section should not exceed 5 pages (excluding 2 page CVs for each PI) with a minimum font size of 11.

- **Introduction and Background**

Include information on species status, conservation needs and current threats. State whether this project was listed as a priority by the IUCN Iguana Specialist Group. If so, state at what level.

NEW - If this project is part of an ongoing effort, include a bulleted list of milestones, by year, as well as the approximate amount of funding received each year to accomplish that milestone.

- **Project description and methods**

Describe the proposed actions and how the project will be conducted. Include overall project goals and objectives. Important: If funds are being requested for more than one project component, i.e., public information campaign AND release and monitoring, describe each component SEPARATELY. Include information for each component on techniques to be used, data analysis, and how information will be utilized and disseminated once the project is completed.

- **Projected Outcomes and Anticipated Conservation Impact**

Describe how the results will be used or applied toward the conservation of the species or its habitat. How will the success of the project, or its components, be evaluated?

- **Project Schedule**

Provide a timetable (beginning and completion) for the major project components

- **Budget and Budget Narrative**

Itemize individual expenses into the following major categories: Labor, Travel, Equipment and Supplies, Other. Please utilize attached chart. PLEASE BE CERTAIN REVIEWERS CAN EASILY DETERMINE WHICH BUDGET ITEMS ARE NEEDED TO CARRY OUT EACH PROJECT COMPONENT. **Total Budget should not exceed \$12,000 US.**

NEW – Please also submit a budget narrative, itemized by budget category and project component, justifying the cost of each line item in the budget chart. Detailed information on equipment requested should be supplied in the narrative.

- **Other Sources of Support:** funding, logistical and technical. Are matching funds available and have they been applied for?

- **Curriculum Vitae:** Please use abbreviated CV, edited to two pages for each PI
